Q. What is Rookie Soccer and how is it different from Preschool Soccer?

- A.
- Rookie Soccer is for kids ages 3 & 4 years old, instruction is provided by Stretch-N-Grow of Utah
 - They will play on Saturdays at the Fieldhouse
 - This will be instruction based with fitness components and other age appropriate skills
 - Preschool soccer (4 years old) is a league based program where they will play games with a team and have practice

Q. When will we hear from a coach?

- A. Our coaches meeting will be the week of August 3rd & August 4th. You should receive a call by the beginning of the next week. If you don't hear from a coach by August 11th, please contact us (655-0999x11) and we will let you know your child's team and first practice.

Q. How many days a week will my child play?

- A. We schedule 2 sessions per week. Some coaches hold other practices but that is up to them when that will be.

Q. Where do we play?

A. All fields in Park City and the Basin area (Treasure Mountain Middle School, North 40, High School fields, Willow Creek Park, Park City's Sports Complex (Quinn's Junction area), Trailside Park, City Park and Ecker Hill Middle School)

Q. Can my child play with a friend or a certain coach?

A. We are going away from the player/coach requests. Teams will be made up of a mix of neighborhoods and schools.

Q. What do they wear?

A. Every player will receive a shirt, shorts and socks; you supply the shin guards and shoes (cleats).

Q. Do you need Coaches?

A. YES, every coach is welcomed. Knowledge of soccer is helpful but not necessary.

Q. How young can my child be?

A. 4 years old, we have a program for 3 year olds (rookie soccer)

Q. Can we get any assistance in payment?

A. Yes, you must stop in to the fieldhouse and fill out a scholarship request form. When it is processed you will be contacted on the conclusion. Cost will be determined upon need.

Q. How long does the program run?

A. The program will end for all leagues by October 10th.

Q. What if my child has never played before?

A. Sign them up! This is a recreational league where everyone is welcome to learn and have fun. There are competitive leagues available in the area if that is more your liking.

Q. Where do you find your coaches?

A. All of our coaches are volunteers. Some have a lot of experience coaching and others it will be their first year.

Q. What time of day are the games played?

A. Weekday games will have start times of 5pm, 5:30pm, 6pm and 6:30pm depending on leagues. All teams will have a variety of start times throughout the season. Weekend games will start at 9am and run until 2pm, again depending on the number of teams in your league.

Q. Will there be a clinic for coaches and players?

A. We will offer a clinic for the coaches at the coaches meeting. We are working on a player clinic during the season but this is not a for sure thing yet.
